Organizational Regulations of the Editorial Board of the Taiwanese Journal of Political Science

1. The Editorial Board of the Taiwanese Journal of Political Science ("the Editorial Board") is established to handle editorial and publication matters for the *Taiwanese Journal of Political Science* of the Department.

2. The Committee consists of between 15 and 19 members, with the Department Chair serving as an ex officio member, and the remaining 14 to 18 members being from both within and outside the Department. The remaining members are appointed by the Department Chair for a term of two years and may serve consecutive terms.

3. The Committee is established as follows:

(1) One Editor-in-Chief, appointed by the Department Chair from among the committee members with responsibility for editorial and publication matters.

The Editor-in-Chief serves for a term of two years and may serve consecutive terms.

(2) One Executive Editor, recommended by the Editor-in-Chief and appointed by the Department Chair to assist with editorial and publication matters.

4. Committee members are convened by the Editor-in-Chief. Resolutions require a quorum of at least one-half of members present and the approval of a majority of the members present to be passed.

5. These Regulations and any amendments thereto are implemented after being approved by the Department Affairs Meeting.
