

Organizational Regulations of the Expenditure Examination Committee of the Department of Political Science,  
National Taiwan University

Approved by the Department Affairs Meeting on June 9, 2009

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1. The Department of Political Science at National Taiwan University establishes the Expenditure Examination Committee (“the Committee”) to create a transparent and accountable mechanism for the use of Department funds and mentorship funds.

2. The Committee is responsible for the following matters:

- (1) Examining the use of funds related to Department affairs.
- (2) Examining the use of mentorship funds.
- (3) Examining the use of the Department’s petty cash.
- (4) Other matters related to funds.

3. The Committee consists of ex-officio and nominated members. The Department Chair serves as the convener and meeting chair.

(1) Ex-officio member: The Department Chair serves as an ex-officio member.

(2) Nominated members: The Department Chair appoints three full-time faculty members of the Department as Committee members.

The term of office of the ex-officio member coincides with the appointment as Department Chair. Nominated members serve for a term of one year and may serve consecutive terms.

4. A quorum of at least half of the members present is required for a Committee Meeting to take place, and resolutions require the approval of a majority of the members present.

5. These Regulations are effective from the date of promulgation after being approved by the Department Affairs Meeting.
