

Organizational Regulations of the Research and Educational Center for China Studies and Cross Taiwan-Strait Relations, Department of Political Science, National Taiwan University

Amended and approved by the Department Affairs Meeting on March 2, 2004

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- Article 1 The Research and Educational Center for China Studies and Cross Taiwan-Strait Relations (“the Center”) is established according to the resolution of the Fourth Department Affairs Meeting of the Department of Political Science of the fall semester of the 2003–2004 academic year, National Taiwan University, held on January 6, 2004.
- Article 2 The purpose of the Center is to promote research on mainland China and enhance the quality of related teaching.
- Article 3 The responsibilities of the Center are as follows:
1. Publishing the *Teaching Newsletter for Mainland China Studies*.
 2. Promoting exchanges with visiting scholars from mainland China.
 3. Organizing educational and knowledge development activities.
 4. Accepting commissioned research projects from within and outside the University.
 5. Examining the integration of relevant academic programs within the University.
- Article 4 The Center has one Director who is responsible for the affairs of the Center. The Director is nominated by the Department Chair and appointed with the consent of the Department Affairs Meeting, with a term of two years, and may be reappointed.
- Article 5 The Center establishes a Committee to review its activities. The Committee consists of between five and seven members who are jointly nominated by the Department Chair and the Center Director and appointed after obtaining the approval of the Department Affairs Meeting. The Committee includes at least one faculty member from each division of the Department.
- Article 6 Meetings of the Committee are convened by the Center Director. At least one meeting is held each semester, and special meetings may be convened when necessary.
- Article 7 Matters to be reviewed by the Committee are as follows:
1. Annual plans.
 2. Annual budget.
 3. Activities related to mainland China and cross-Strait relations.
 4. Other related matters.
- Article 8 All activities of the Center are carried out collaboratively by the faculty of the Department involved in the Center, and research groups may be established as necessary to promote the activities.
- Article 9 The Center may have one Executive Director, who is appointed by the Center Director to assist in handling the affairs of the Center.

- Article 10 The Center may invite scholars and experts to serve as advisory committee members, and their appointment is reported by the Director of the Center to the Department Affairs Meeting for record. Advisory committee members serve for a term of one year.
- Article 11 The Center's operations and financial overview are reported to the Department Affairs Meeting before the end of each academic year.
- Article 12 The Center is subject to a comprehensive review of its operations conducted by the Department.
- Article 13 These Regulations take effect from the date of promulgation after being approved by the Department Affairs Meeting and are reported to the College for record.
