

Regulations for the Establishment of the New Faculty Selection Committee of the Department of Political
Science, College of Social Sciences, National Taiwan University

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- Article 1 These Regulations are established in accordance with Article 7 of the *Regulations for the Appointment of Full-Time Faculty Members of the College of Social Sciences, National Taiwan University*.
- Article 2 The New Faculty Selection Committee of the Department (“the Committee”) is divided into subcommittees for evaluating candidates in the Political Theory, International Relations, and Public Administration divisions. Each subcommittee consists of eight full-time faculty members at the rank of associate professor or higher, appointed by the Department’s Faculty Evaluation Committee (excluding faculty members on secondment), along with one faculty member at the rank of associate professor or higher appointed by the Dean of the College of Social Sciences. The Department Chair serves as an ex-officio member and convener of each subcommittee.
- Subcommittee members serve for a term of one year and may serve consecutive terms.
- Article 3 The Committee is responsible for handling matters related to the reappointment planning for faculty members by each subcommittee after coordinating with the other subcommittees and making recommendations to the Department Affairs Meeting or the Faculty Evaluation Committee. In the event of any disputes regarding the aforementioned coordination issues, a joint subcommittee meeting or a full committee meeting may be convened to make a decision.
- Article 4 Each subcommittee of the Committee meets at least once each academic year. A special meeting may be held under any of the following circumstances:
1. When at least one-third of the members of a subcommittee request a meeting.
 2. When the Department Affairs Meeting resolves to convene a meeting.
 3. When the Department Chair deems it necessary to convene a meeting.
- Article 5 A quorum of at least two-thirds of the members present is required for a Committee Meeting to take place, and resolutions require the approval of a majority of the members present.
- Article 6 Matters not specified in these Regulations are handled in accordance with the relevant regulations of the University and the College.
- Article 7 These regulations are implemented from the date of promulgation after being approved by the Department Affairs Meeting and submitted to the College for approval for reference.
