

Regulations for the Organization of the Academic Exchange Committee, Department of Political Science,
National Taiwan University

Approved by the Department Affairs Meeting on March 2, 2004

- Article 1 The Academic Exchange Committee (“the Committee”) is established according to the resolution of the Fourth Department Affairs Meeting of the Department of Political Science, National Taiwan University of the fall semester of the 2003–2004 academic year, held on January 6, 2004.
- Article 2 The purpose of the Committee is to strengthen exchanges and cooperation between faculty and students of the Department and the domestic and international academic community.
- Article 3 The responsibilities of the Committee are as follows:
1. Promoting collaborative teaching and research projects between the Department and the domestic and international academic community.
 2. Promoting mutual visits between the Department and the domestic and international academic community.
 3. Organizing forums and academic conferences.
 4. Assisting graduate students in conducting short-term research abroad or in mainland China.
 5. Promoting other academic activities that align with the purposes of the Committee.
- Article 4 The Committee consists of between five and seven members, with the Department Chair serving as an ex-officio member, and the remaining members nominated by the Department Chair and appointed after obtaining the approval of the Department Affairs Meeting. Committee members serve for a term of two year and may serve consecutive terms.
- Article 5 The Committee has one convener responsible for promoting its activities. The convener is elected by the committee members from among themselves.
- Article 6 These Regulations and any amendments thereto are implemented after obtaining the approval of the Department Affairs Meeting.
